

Market Rabbit & Af Budget

There are two options to consider when choosing your market rabbits. You can show a meat pen which consists of three rabbits and are judged on meat quality, body type and uniformity, or a single fryer which is one rabbit and is judged on meat quality and body type. You will have the project for roughly **thirty days**. You will be required to attend one work day a week, along with daily feeding, watering and exercising your rabbit. Showmanship for rabbits is quite difficult and you will need to practice in order to do a good job. Before you



receive your fair check you must attend a farm clean up (date to be determined by advisor), complete your FFA record book and bring all thank you letters to your advisor, stamped and ready to be mailed.
